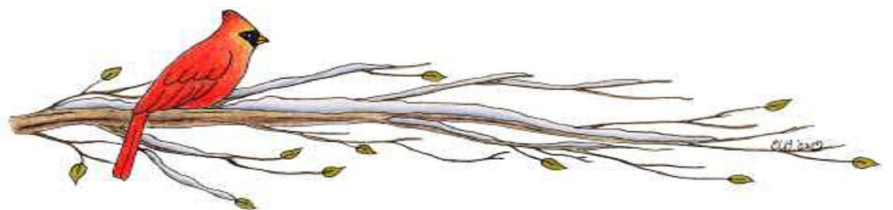

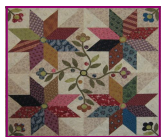

## February Block of the Month Agnes Gates

### Clue 2

Make 48 half-square triangle units, using the 3" light and dark strips.

Trim the units to measure: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square.

Press seams toward the dark triangles. I remind you to be sure of your 1/4 "seam.



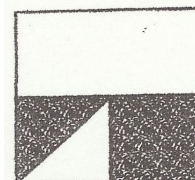
### Clue 3

Join the 2 1/2" dark squares to the half square triangle units, you made in step 2 to make 48 units that look like this.



### Clue 4

Join the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" LIGHT rectangles to the units you made in Step 3 to make 48 units that look like this.



Make 48

Press seams toward the DARK fabric. The units should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

**STRAWBERRY GRAND MARNIER CHEESECAKE DIP**

1/2 cup finely chopped strawberries  
1/2 finely chopped walnuts, toasted  
1/4 c brown sugar  
1/4 c Grand Marnier (optional) or orange juice  
6 oz softened cream cheese  
1/2 c sour cream  
1/3 c 10X sugar

Combine berries, brown sugar and Grand Marnier or  
orange juice. Set aside.

Blend the cream cheese, sour cream and 10X sugar.  
Beat until smooth. Stir strawberries to dissolve sugar  
and then blend into cream cheese mixture. Fold in the  
walnuts. Cover and chill.

Suggested dippers: chocolate wafers, graham crackers,  
ladyfingers, bananas or fresh strawberries
