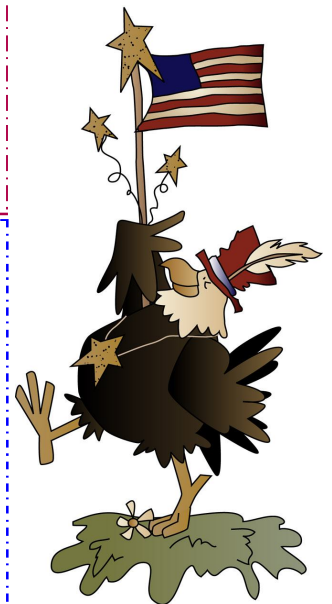

Bring a smile and your quilts for show and share, and a place setting.

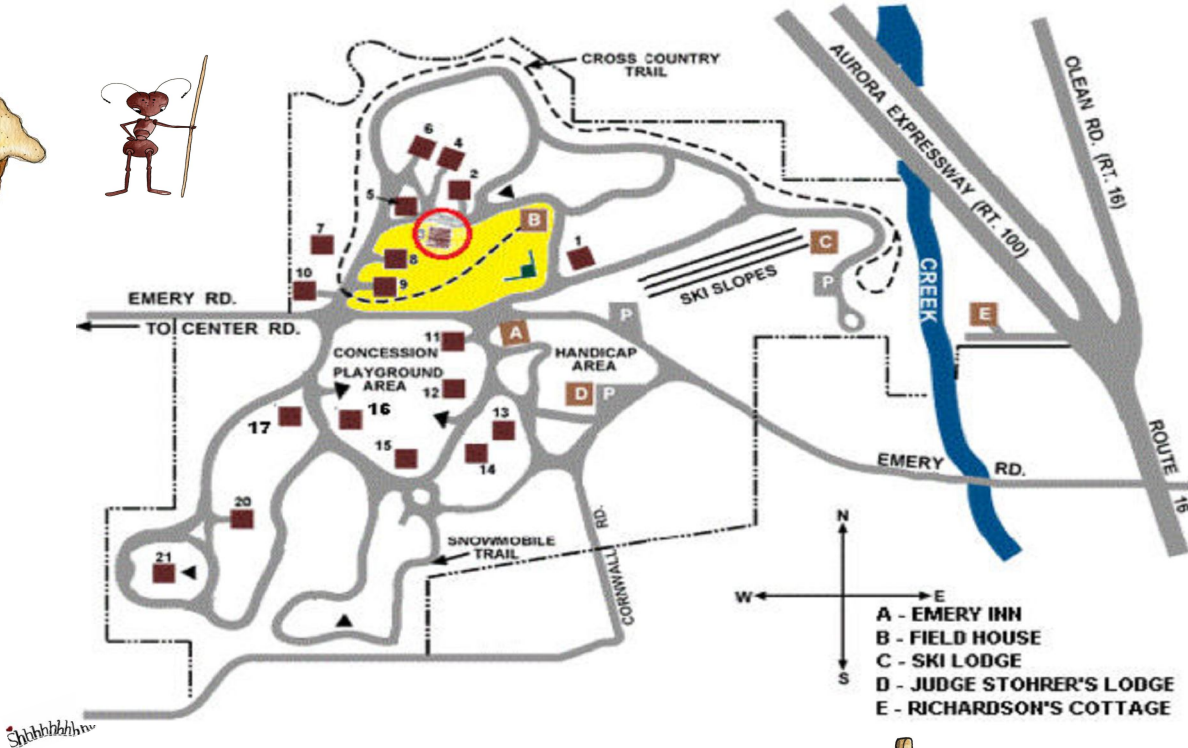
A big warm thank you to all who participated in the mystery BOM. The quilts were amazing and very nicely done. Hugs, Agnes

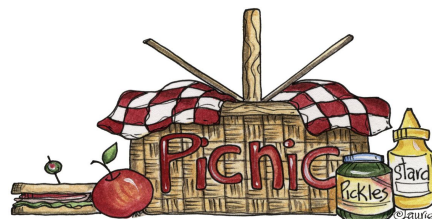


Map to the picnic Shelter #3.

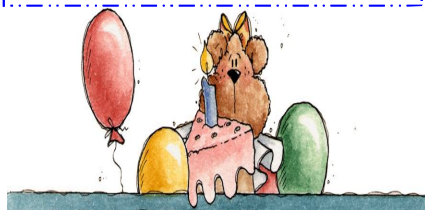

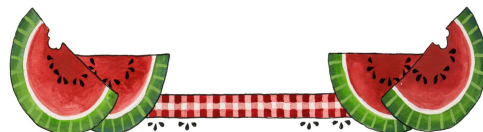

Symptoms:

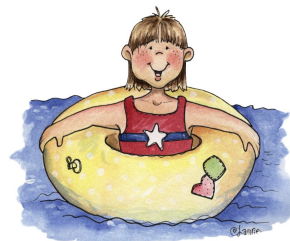
1. Causes you to send the same e-mail twice. Done that!
